TEACHER CHECKLIST

We're excited that you are supporting keeping Texas beautiful through your participation in the Don't mess with Texas K-12 Calendar Art Contest! Below, you'll find a quick checklist of things to look out for as you support your students in submitting their artwork for the best chance to become a winner.

- The student is enrolled K-12 grade and has received permission to participate from their parent or guardian.
- The student's name is on the back of their artwork - nowhere else!
- I have attached the student's entry form to the back of their unique artwork.
- Each piece of artwork submitted promotes the Don't mess with Texas and/or Keep Texas Beautiful mission.
- Each piece of artwork submitted promotes the protection of our Texas highways and environment from litter.
- Each piece of artwork has all words spelled correctly - I have double-checked!
- None of the student's artwork includes company brands or store names - only DMWT and KTB.
- All of the student entries fit on an 8.5x11" piece of paper, are flat/two-dimensional and are not framed or mounted.
- The student artwork can be made using watercolor, acrylic or oil paints, colored pencil, markers, ink, charcoal, pastels and crayons. Computer-generated artwork, traced images or copies are not allowed for submission!
- The student artwork is placed in the mail on or before the deadline of April 18, 2019.
